We are pleased to announce a call for posters open to PhD students and postdoctoral researchers, as part of the 4th edition of the **Post-Quantum Cryptography workshop**, held during the **European Cyber Week** in Rennes on 18-19 November 2026.

Organised by the DGA with the support of CREACH LABS, in partnership with ANSSI, the University of Rennes and the Pôle d'Excellence Cyber, this workshop brings together the academic, industrial and institutional communities -- from the design of schemes to their implementation and evaluation.

It offers a unique setting to compare approaches and combine, in a single venue, strategic perspectives, hands-on field experience and cutting-edge research.

The poster session is an opportunity to present ongoing work and to engage in discussion with specialists from a range of disciplines.

Submissions may address, but are not limited to:

- **New post-quantum cryptographic schemes** (design, security, cryptanalysis).
- **The performance and optimisation of primitives.**
- **Software, hardware or embedded implementation, and resistance to side-channel physical attacks.**
- **Integration, large-scale deployment and cryptographic transition.**

Important

- Poster (format A0) and abstract written in **English** (international audience).
- Each accepted poster will be the subject of a short 3-minute talk. The best poster will be awarded a prize during the event. The best poster will be awarded a prize during the event.

- A one-page abstract describing the topic of the poster, with name, affiliation and contact details.
- Deadline: **11th October 2026**.
- Notification: **18th October 2026**.
